## DINING HALL

- 1. Remain in formation until dismissed.
- 2. When dismissed proceed to tables through fourthclass aisles (aisles with no black chairs) retaining a proper position of attention with eyes on the floor.
- 3. At tables, place hat under chair and assume position of attention behind chair, eyes down.
- 4. Take seats after directed to do so by table commandant.
- 5. Basic cadet at the foot of table will address the table commandant immediately and state, "Cadet\_\_\_\_, sir, the beverages for the meal are\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_. Does Cadet \_\_\_\_ care for the beverages at this time?" The same basic cadet will then say, "Sir, does Cadet\_\_\_\_ or any other gentleman at the table care for coffee or hot water at the meal?"
- 6. After main course has arrived, basic cadet says, "Cadet \_\_\_\_\_, sir, do you care for the main course at this time?"
- 7. After the table commandant's plate has been passed in, basic cadet says, "Cadet\_\_\_\_\_, sir, do you care for dessert at this time?"
- 8. After the dessert has been tasted, the basic cadet says, "Cadet \_\_\_\_, sir, do you have any remarks or suggestions for the Form 0-96 at this time?"
- 9. At dismissal, basic cadets will stand without command and wait for "Post" from the table commandant. After the command "Post", basic cadets will say in unison, "Excuse me sir, excuse me gentlemen, good \_\_\_\_\_, sir."
- 10. Basic cadets will not under any circumstances take any food from the dining hall.
- 11. Basic cadets may be expected to demonstrate professional knowledge at the table commandant's discretion.

## CUSTOMS AND COURTESIES

1. <u>Greeting:</u> Basic Cadets should greet all upperclassmen and officers in a loud and respectful manner with the appropriate greeting:

0600 - 1200 -- Good morning, sir. 1200 - 1800 -- Good afternoon, sir. 1800 - 2200 -- Good evening, sir.

- 2. <u>Saluting:</u> Basic Cadets will salute all officers when out of doors and covered, and when reporting. Basic Cadets will salute the SOD (silver armband and sabre) when not in formation.
- 3. Reporting: When reporting to an upperclass room with the door closed, Basic Cadets will knock twice firmly and wait for reply from within. If door is opened by an upperclassman, report in normal manner. If door is not opened by an upperclassman, report in normal manner. If door is not opened and questioned as to identify, the Basic Cadet will reply "Sir, it is Basic Cadet \_\_\_\_\_."

When reporting to an upperclassman or officer at a desk, Basic Cadet will remove hat and hold it in his left hand, proceed to a position in front of desk, salute, and say, "Sir, Basic Cadet \_\_\_\_\_\_ reporting (as ordered/to ask a question/to make a statement)". When superior indicates that the interview is finished, the Basic Cadet will take one step backward, salute, and say "Good (morning, afternoon, or evening), sir". Basic cadets will proceed in the most direct manner to door, replace headgear, and leave, closing door behind him. Basics will execute no facing movements when reporting or leaving.

- 4. By Your Leave, Sir: When basics approach an upperclassman or officer in the hallway, the basic cadet will turn and stand with back toward the wall, render appropriate greeting when upperclassman passes, and then continue on his way. Basics should not hit wall or touch wall. This is a show of courtesy.
- 5. <u>Insignia:</u> All insignia will be allowed on shirts and alpha blouses while in closets.
- 6. Basics will carry Contrails and pen in their pockets at all times.
- 7. <u>Knowledge:</u> Basic cadets will be responsible for professional knowledge according to the following schedule (taps of date indicated):
  - 8 July 1971 Cadet and Air Force Chain of Command Group and Squadron Staffs
  - 9 July 1971 Cadet and Officer Rank, Insignia Discipline quotation
  - 12 July 1971 Fighters, bombers, tankers, (numerical designation, manufacture, armament, range, engine(s), purpose, unique features or uses, nickname)
    Aircraft on mall
  - 14 July 1971 American Fighting Man's Code of Conduct First two quotes in Contrails
  - 16 July 1971 Attack, trainers (same specs. as above)

- 18 July 71 Quotations 3-7
- 19 July 71 Quotations 8-12
- 21 July 71 Star Spangled Banner (all four stanzas)
