3 June 1975 - 10:00 AM

Graduation Parade and USAF Academy Aerial Review: (Cadet Parade Ground)

Open to the public. Seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis, except for Superintendent's invited guests. In case of inclement weather, these events will be cancelled.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Same as Organizational Awards Parade.

Open House: The Cadet Chapel, Cadet Gym, Fairchild Hall, Field House, and the Aero Science Lab will be open to cadets, their guests, and USAF Academy personnel. 9:00 PM

Graduation Ball: (Arnold Hall)

Swearing-in Ceremony: (Cadet Area)

For the graduating cadets and their invited guests. At this ceremony the graduates are officially administered the Federal Oath of Office. The specific location will be determined by individual squadrons. Dress: Depending upon the time this event is held, the attire worn to the Graduation Ball or the Graduation Ceremony is appropriate.

Parking: Available in the Cadet Area

Graduation Ceremony and USAF Thunderbird Demonstration: (Falcon Stadium)

Open to the public.

Tickets: Each graduate receives seven guest tickets for seats in Falcon Stadium or the Field House. If ceremony is held in Falcon Stadium, extra seats will be available.

Dress: The appropriate dress is a lightweight suit or afternoon dress.

Parking: Around Falcon Stadium.

Alternate Plan: In the event of inclement weather, the graduation ceremony will be conducted in the Field House. Due to the limited capacity, only those guests of graduates with tickets will be allowed to attend.

Parking: Available in lots near the Field House.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Due to the high altitude of the Academy (7,250'), many people arriving here from lower altitudes experience difficulty in walking moderate distances and in climbing the many hills which grace our campus. Our buildings are multi-story structures with many flights of stairs. The June Week schedule is a very fast, active and exciting one. These factors, combined with an attempt to keep up with your cadet caught up in the excitement of his own graduation, can cause discomfort if you do not allow yourself enough time to rest each day.

Traffic: 7,000 parents, guests and visitors are expected to attend June Week activities this year. With these large numbers you can anticipate heavy traffic and parking and seating problems at many functions. Please allow yourself sufficient time to travel from your lodging to the Academy each day to preclude last minute rushing.

Climate: It is suggested that parents and guests have sunglasses, raincoats and/or umbrellas available for all scheduled outside events, and that all ladies planning to wear an afternoon dress have a light wrap available if cool, windy weather is forecast. Normally, Colorado has delightful weather during the month of June — sunny, warm days and cool evenings. We are hoping for the best weather ever during graduation week.

June Week will commence on Friday, 30 May 1975, and will end with the graduation ceremony on Wednesday morning, 4 June 1975.

ARNOLD HALL

Arnold Hall is the Cadet Social Center and the meeting place for all cadets and their guests.
